

Rietdijk B.V. Valuations terms and procedures

Auctions

We are constantly looking for large and small(er) lots for our bi-annual auctions. To obtain material for our auctions we offer estimate of market- and auctions values free of charge. If require, we also value your possessions for the purposes of insurance and replacement.

No-charge assessments at our offices

Valuations for an indication of the potential auction value are always without obligations and free of charge when carried out on our premises. This is possible from Monday to Friday, from 09.00 to 17.00. Please make an appointment in advance so that the relevant assessor can keep the appropriate time free.

Free of charge valuations at your home or other designated location

A free-of-charge on-site valuation is in principle available for material whose potential at auction is at least € 5.000,-. To avoid unnecessary cost our advisor will first consult you. These valuations also take place during office hours. If our expert's visit leads to a lot being submitted for auction there are no charges.

Valuation tariffs

In all cases other than those described above charges are due, based on the following tariffs:

Normal: 2% of the estimate value with a minimum of € 200,- collections with a value up to € 5.000,- 1½% of the estimated value with a minimum of € 200,-. To which in both cases is added 21% VAT and travel costs of € 0,29 per kilometre, from the Hague Noordeinde to address and vice versa.

Alternative: € 125,- per hour with a minimum of € 200,- to which is added 21% VAT and travel costs of € 0,29 per kilometre from the Hague Noordeinde to address and vice versa.

Note ! If you have paid valuation fees but still decide to put your material up for auctions at Rietdijk within a year, the cost will be reimbursed to you (minus VAT and travel costs).

Auction Fee

When you decide to put material up for auction an auction fee applies. This fee depends largely on the value and nature of the material submitted. In close consultation between you and Rietdijk, after valuation of your collection, we are able to propose an auction fee, to which material can be taken in to auction. In short, the higher the value the lower the auction fee, the more time consuming, the higher the auction fee will be. There has to be found a balance in the percentage of auction commission in value, work and return for both parties.
